

WhatsApp Scamming Message on HSBC Loans

We wish to bring to the attention of our customers and the public that a fraudulent WhatsApp message is circulating asking recipients to reach out to a Senior Manager of the HSBC to avail from loan facilities free of cost.

Please note that this is a scam as HSBC is not offering such facilities and does not communicate product offering in this manner.

HSBC urges its customers and the public to exercise caution when receiving similar WhatsApp messages.

To avoid falling prey to these WhatsApp scams, we recommend the following:

- ◆ Do not click on any links or open any attachments
- ◆ Do not call or reply on the number provided in the message
- ◆ If you receive any unsolicited messages, you should delete the message and report the sender to WhatsApp by going to Settings >Help> Contact us
